 (Not Teacher Academy Students)

As of the spring 2009 semester, the undergraduate program in secondary education mathematics will be comprised of the following six courses:

| <i>Fall of Junior year</i> | EDS 201 or EDS 202 (foundation classes) | Students can be advised to start taking one of them. | <i>Fall of Junior Year</i> | EDS 201 and EDS 202 | Students are advised to take both classes, during which the application package is completed. |
| <i>Spring of Junior Year</i> | EDS 201 or/and EDS 202 | They need to take and finish both of them. They will be given the application package in these classes to apply to the education program. | <i>Spring of Junior Year</i> | EDS 317 (This is a course replacement for the present EDS 307) EDS 201 or 202 | Students may take one of the foundation classes (EDS 201/202) this semester if they were granted permission not to take it the previous term. |
| <i>Fall of Senior Year</i> | EDS 303 and EDS 307 (only in fall) | They will take both methods classes. | <i>Fall of Senior Year</i> | EDS 303 | This now follows EDS 317. |
| <i>Spring of Senior Year</i> | EDS 400 and EDS 401 | They will take both: student teaching and seminar. | <i>Spring of Senior Year</i> | EDS 400 and EDS 401 | They will take both: student teaching and seminar. |
